Report for 2018-2019

Dear all beloved friends, brothers and sisters,

On behalf of teachers and students, we would like to say thank you so much to all our supporters in Australia who have been supporting the children in Cambodia through GC in Australia. We cannot thank you enough and we appreciate your time, effort and kind-hearted assistance at all the fund-raisings. Without all the amazing jobs that you have done so far, our students would not be able to get better jobs or continue their further education.

Here are the reports of our students, teachers and other activities as below:

There are currently

- 4 teachers and 264 students at Oroluos School
- 3 teachers and 180 students at Beng school
- 1 teacher and 51 students at kok Beng school
- 2 teachers and 159 students at Koy Meng school
- Oroluos and Beng schools: Hours are from 2:00pm in the afternoon until 7:00pm in the evening.
- Kok Beng: Hours are from 5:30pm 7:30pm
- Koy Meng: Hours are from 8:00am 3:00pm

Students come from villages to study English at GC; those who go to primary or secondary schools in the morning attend GC in the afternoon, while those who attend other schools in the afternoon, come to GC in the evening.

After attending the English lessons at GC School for more than six years, we have identified that, the students' command of English, such as their writing, speaking, reading, listening, and spelling - have improved immeasurably. All of GC's students are very keen and determined to continue developing their English skills. 90% of students passed their exams and moved to the next level.

All students attend because they want to learn not because of they are compelled to attend. Due partially to the excellent standard of our teachers.

After learning the foundation of English at GC School for more than one year, students are ready to move on to the next level, called Let's Go Starter.

Let's Go level 1 move to Let's Go level 2 and Let's Go level 2 moved to Let's Go level 3

Students who graduate from Family and Friends level 1 move to Family and Friends level 2.

According to the teaching curriculum at our school, teachers are very methodical and do many reviews on their lessons. For the children, teachers teach one letter of the alphabet and draw a corresponding picture. For Let's Go levels 1, 2 and 3, teachers teach 2 or 3 words a day and make the 2 or 3 words into sentences. Teachers use a lot of visual references (drawings), to make understanding easier for the students.

For Family & Friends level 1 & 2, students improved greatly in their reading, writing, listening and speaking. They can communicate in English with their teachers and classmates.

For those who did not pass the exam, they will repeat that level. We have identified some of the reasons why students could not keep up with their lessons or failed in their exams – eg. because state schools changed schedules: one month in the morning and then one month in the afternoon – meaning our students had to change their study and work schedule as well.

For the new academic year of 2019, we have classified the teaching curriculum into two semesters and four terms.

We teach the following books:

- Let's Go starter
- Let's Go level 1, 2, and 3
- Family & Friends level 1, 2 & 3
- New-Headway Straight-forward

At the end of every month, all students are tested on the same day, and those who receive the highest scores are acknowledged by having their names added to our Honours List.

For this academic year of 2019, we have added a new motivational goal for the top students who pass their monthly tests: we provide the top 5 students at each level with a 'Certificate of Achievement'.

To receive this certificate, the children must work hard and compete against their fellow students. Our teachers also insert conversational lessons into their daily teaching.

On behalf of the students, we would like to say "thank you So Much" to The Committee of GC and Donors for the support. We students will try our best to study and learn.
